A well-balanced cat with conformation indicating power, endurance, agility.

Essence of American Shorthairs

- Working cat
- No part so exaggerated as to foster weakness
- A strongly built, well-balanced, symmetrical cat with conformation indicating Power, Endurance, and Agility
- Medium to large breed females may be less massive and rewarded equally if overall balance is correct





Head / Eye Color – 35% Body / Coat – 45% Color / Pattern – 20%

Head

- Large full cheeked face
- Sweet expression
- Oblong slightly longer than wide
- 2 equal parts
 - Middle eyes to ear base
 - Middle eyes to chin
- Ears Medium, rounded
- Chin Firm, well developed



GCD BWR RW – Brown Tabby male

Head (continued)

- Forehead Moderate convex curve over top of head to neck
- Nose moderate length gentle concave rise from nose to forehead
- Eyes Unique to Breed
 - Upper lid almond shaped
 - Lower lid fully rounded
 - Outer corner higher than inner






GC RW DM – Silver Patched Tabby & White female

Body

- Slightly longer than tall
- 3 equal parts
 - Breast bone to elbow
 - Elbow to hind legs
 - Front hind legs to buttocks
- Tail medium heavy base
- Legs parallel, medium, heavily muscled

Coat

- Short, thick, even, hard
- Dense to protect from moisture, cold, skin injuries

- Mackerel
- Ticked


GC Silver Ticked Tabby male

Colors

Allowed colors:

- White, Black, Red
- Dilute Blue, Cream,
- Silver Silver, Cameo
- & White/Vans (including Bicolors and Calico)

More than 100 different possible color/pattern combinations possible

Penalize

- Excessive cobbiness or ranginess •
- Very short tail


Disqualify

- nginess Evidence of hybridization
 - Long fur
 - Deep nose break
 - Brow ridge
 - Hybridized colors
 - chocolate, sable, lavender, lilac or point restricted
 - Abnormal tail
 - Obesity or emaciation

Any feature so exaggerated as to foster weakness

Handling

- Support firmly
- Put all four feet on the table (4 on the floor)
- Use teaser, but don't over stimulate
- Allow controlled movement to
 observe balance & structure
- Feel the coat for hardness/density and body for muscling
- Check undercoat color
